Karlis Saltups is a Certified architect who has been leading an architectural company in Latvia for several years.

In cooperation with local and Norwegian architectural offices, the company has gained recognition in major international and local architectural competitions, including the Second World War Museum in Gdansk, Poland, The Viking Ship Museum in Oslo, Norway and the Maritime Museum in Liepāja, Latvia.

Karlis Saltups is a member of the concept design group who developed the sketch project for the Latvian Pavilion in Shanghai Expo 2010. The philosophy and the message we presented through the National pavilion: "The road to happiness leads through harmony between nature and technology". 190 countries participated in the exhibition and, over six months, the Expo Shanghai 2010 attracted 73 million visitors.

In 2012 Kārlis Saltups received a Diploma in Architecture and Urban Planning at Riga Technical University. His Master's thesis "Sustainable House Community" received recognition for research topicality from the Latvian Association of Architects. Karlis Saltups, as a guest lecturer, attended the educational institutions of young architects in order to present the results of the Master thesis and educate them on the topic of eco-villages. Karlis Saltups used this theoretical knowledge in practice by implementing sustainable architectural projects.
